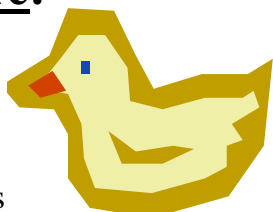


What To Bring – Spa class

- m Plastic bag for each foot (not ziploc; vegetable bags from grocery store work best)
- m Hot water in large thermal container
- m Profile Card
- m Sales Ticket
- m Ink Pen
- m Beauty Book
- m Look Book
- m Create-A-Roll-Up Closing Sheet
- m Tic-Tac-Toe Sheet
- m Hostess/Class Packet
- m Prizes (see bottom box for Studio guidelines)
